

The John T. Hood & Martha Emma Yancey Hood Scholarship

The Scholarship will provide one \$1,000 scholarship annually to a member of the United Methodist congregation within the bounds of the North Georgia Annual Conference who is enrolled or enrolling as a full-time student in an accredited Georgia United Methodist seminary. The applicant's goal must be to serve as an Ordained Elder in the North Georgia Annual Conference. The applicant will also be engaged in the candidacy process supervised by the North Georgia Annual Conference Board of Ordained Ministry.

The following information **must** accompany this application before the scholarship can be considered:

1. Documentation of enrollment as a full-time student in an accredited Georgia United Methodist seminary; and
2. Documentation that the student is engaged in the candidacy process; and
3. A statement about applicant's call to and vision of ordained ministry (no more than two typed pages).

The application deadline is May 1.
